### Notice of Race

July 25-28, 2007

**Organizing Authority:** Sandusky Sailing Club and ISCA Fleet 1

**Sanctioning Authority:** Interlake Sailing Class Association

**Rules:** This regatta will be governed by the "rules" as defined by *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) and the ISCA Bylaws for sanctioned events.

**Category:** Category C as defined under Article IX of the ISCA Interlake Specifications.

**Eligibility:** All persons who meet the current ISCA requirements for sanctioned events who are members of the Association as provided for under Article VI of the Bylaws.

**Sailing Instructions:** Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

**Entry and Registration:** Entry forms will be available on the ISCA website and in future issues of the Intercom. The entry fee for the Nationals will be \$85.00 (non U.S. Sailing members \$95.00). Entry fees are payable to Sandusky Sailing Club and must be postmarked by July 1, 2007. Entries posted marked after July 1, 2007 will be assessed a \$25 late fee. (Note: banquet tickets are **not** available to those entries post marked after July 1, 2007) Please mail registration with check to:

**Racing:** No qualifying series is planned. All Contestants shall choose to sail in either the Championship or Challenger Fleet at the time of registration. A total of ten (10) races with multiple back to back races with a daily lunch break are planned. Three (3) races will constitute the regatta.

**Courses:** The courses to be sailed will be provided for in the Sailing Instructions.

**Scoring:** Scoring shall be in accordance with RRS Appendix A, Low Point System. Each yacht's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races, excluding her worst score if 6 or more races are completed. This changes rule A2.

**Trophies:** Championship Perpetual: National Champion and National Champion Crew.  
Championship individuals: First thru-tenth-place (1-10) for skipper and crew.  
Challenger perpetual: Challenger Champion and Challenger Crew.  
Challenger individuals: First thru fifth place (1-5) for skipper and crew.  
Other: Best First Nationals outside the Top Ten, F.K. Holtzman Award (Best Fleet Participation.)

**Measurement:** Completion of the Measurement Form is a mandatory part of registration. Measurement will be conducted on Saturday, June 23 from 0900 - 1200, Tuesday, July 24 from 1800 to 2100 and on Wednesday, July 25th from 0900 to 1700. All boats must be on club grounds by 1600 on July 25<sup>th</sup> and complete the registration by 1800. This rule will be strictly enforced, with the exception of unavoidable circumstances as approved by the National Race Committee.
